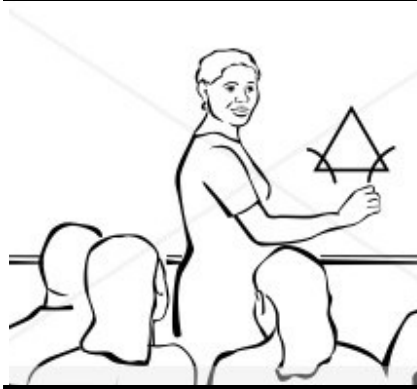

CJH was developed from Camp Jewell, a summer enrichment program founded in 1980. Nestled in Decatur, Georgia, CJH allows scholars from pre-k thru 12th grade the opportunity to progress to their fullest potential by meeting the individual needs of each student. As a result of the warm, caring, structured environment that CJH provides; our students develop self esteem, self awareness, self reliance, and self management. We are committed to achieving success with each scholar who becomes apart of the CJH family.



Vision

Our vision is to build a community of warmth, respect, mutual cooperation, friendship, leadership and compassion for our scholars in order to create a trail of success. The scholars, facilitators, therapists, and staff are a team working together for a common purpose and cause. Camp Jewell House provides emotional, social, physical, and academic support for the growth and development of at-risk and underprivileged scholars. We believe that every one has the ability to learn and develop.

Mission

It is our mission to guide scholars in developing stalwart character in a loving, nurturing, and educational environment that maintains the highest degree of integrity.

Goals

Camp Jewell House (CJH) features a comprehensive integration of academics with the therapeutic and emotional growth components. Comparable emphasis is placed on a student's personal development alongside their academic growth. And as a small, nurturing community featuring a structured and safe daily life, the two are seamlessly connected. In this light, the CJH academic program strives for:

- **Student success**, which, for some of our scholars, may be unprecedented, and the achievement of which bolsters feelings of confidence and pride.
- **A sustained love of learning**, so that pursuant to the CJH academic mission statement scholars are inspired to become lifelong learners.
- **Critical thinking skills**, and not the mere regurgitation of facts, in order to create an enhanced

degree of self-awareness and understanding.

- **A sense of self-discipline**, so that scholars are better organized, self-sufficient, and focused.

Program

Camp Jewell House services at-risk scholars in the following areas:

- **Social:** Learning social skills and interaction in the community is a daily way of life. Involvement in the community teaches the importance of social interaction.
 - **Mental:** CJH offers an extremely challenging, fully accredited and innovative academic curriculum and progressive academic credit recovery program for scholars who have fallen behind. We offer a **15:1** student teacher ratio. We take a holistic approach to education. Each scholar is tested upon entry and based on the scholars academic level the curriculum is built around the individual.
 - **Emotional:** CJH assists in the emotional growth of each scholar. Scholars participate in individual therapy, group therapy, and family therapy on a weekly basis.
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
